On achieving their qualification, learners are then signed up to NEWTEC's Recruitment Agency who provide both childcare and health and social care workers to provisions that may be understaffed. Within this team learners are supported with CV writing and interview skills to ensure they are work ready.

NEWTEC also offers a Children's Centre that provides a wide range of learning and development activities for children and their families.
