Clinical staff includes psychologists, family therapists, nurses, psychiatrists, social workers, psychotherapists all of whom are supported by bi-lingual co-workers and the administrative team.

The service works in close partnership with other agencies providing serviced to children and young people in the borough e.g. Children's Social Care, Schools and Docklands Outreach.
