We have recently added a Japanese garden to our play space, which offers a calm, peaceful corner away from the hurly-burly of the playground.

We offer many opportunities for parents to work alongside their children as well as to learn for themselves. We also have a long-standing commitment to the professional development of our adult team. We hope that our pupils are able to thrive and develop in their school and we have high expectations of them in terms of their achievement and their conduct.
