We can provide free restorative justice conferences to secondary schools to help resolve disputes between pupils or between schools and parents.

We can deliver workshops to parents and carers and local organisations on online safety at home for children and young people. We can also work with schools and families to resolve particularly challenging incidents of bullying.

We also provide training, support and advice to schools to promote the inclusion of pupils with challenging behaviour and social and emotional difficulties.

Parent' and carers' workshops on online safety for children and young people are provided to parents and families.
