We provide a range of support for babies, children and young people diagnosed with sensory impairment, including those with additional and complex needs.

The Sensory Support Service consists of specialist teachers of the deaf and of vision impairment. There are other professionals who work with us, for example, bilingual instructors and a deaf instructor.

We provide support for pre-school as well as school aged children and young people. We work in close partnership with other specialists including staff skilled in the assessment of dual sensory impaired children.
